### ABSTRACT

The 10<sup>th</sup> International Conference on Zinc and Zinc Alloy Coated Steel Sheet (Galvatech2015) intends to give steelmakers, users and researchers the opportunity of discussing scientific and technological issues related to production and use of Zinc and Zinc Alloy coated steel sheets. The body of the abstract should not exceed 150 words in length.

### INTRODUCTION

This is the instruction for preparation of manuscripts for Galvatech2015 and this file can be used as a template. The authors are asked to ensure uniformity and continuity for the proceedings publication and prepare their manuscripts according to this instruction. For those who do not have Microsoft Word, other software, i.e. LaTeX and Page Maker etc. can be used as long as your manuscript is written in accordance with this instruction. In that case, please convert the file into PDF before submission.

Manuscript should be typed in one column and single-spaced. Please use US letter size paper. The recommended margins for the letter-size are:

Top	1.75 in. (44.5 mm)
Bottom	0.75 in. (12.7 mm)
Left	0.75 in. (12.7 mm)
Right	1.0 in. (25.4 mm)

Main text: 10pt, Times New Roman, Single-spaced

The first page should contain the title of your paper along with all the authors' names, their affiliations, their street address, and their countries. The authors' name should be separated from the title by two blank lines. After this information, abstract and keywords should be placed. The major heading ABSTRACT should be separated from the last author entry by one blank line. You can begin typing the main text after two blank lines. The references should be placed at the end.

Manuscript should be written in 8 pages at a maximum.

### PREPARATION OF MANUSCRIPT

The manuscript must be prepared in proper English. SI units or acceptable metric equivalents should be used throughout. Text paragraphs should be single-spaced and left justified.

### Fonts

The authors are asked to use "Times New Roman". Use the software in the single-byte code. Do not use 2-bytes

Bottom margin: 1 in. (2.54 cm)

Second-Level Heading: 10pt, Times New Roman, Bold, First letter of each major word in capital

Third-Level Heading: 10pt, Times New Roman, Underlined

### Equations

All equations are centered and are properly separated from the text lines. They are numbered consecutively in parentheses at the right-hand margin.

### Figures and Tables

#### Figures

Figures should be centered and placed as closely as possible to the appropriate text. Place a blank line before and after each figure for separating the figures from the text. Each figure should be consecutively numbered and has to contain caption under the figure. They should be graphic images with halftones and should be prepared with 300 dpi resolution at least. Please confirm that figures are printed clearly before submitting your manuscript. Photos and graphs can be in color, but please note that any hard copy may be printed in black and white.

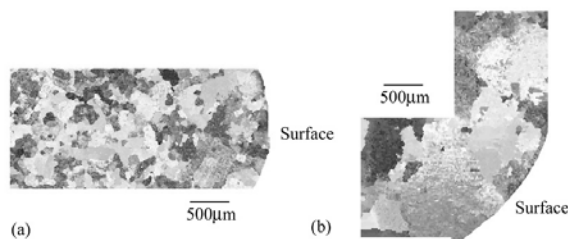


Figure 1 Microstructure of the alloys

#### Tables

Tables should be centered and placed as closely as possible to their references. Each table should be consecutively numbered and has to contain caption above the table. Please make sure that each table appears clearly.

Table-wide lines should separate the title from the column headings, the column headings from the body of the table, and the table from the following text. Footnotes belonging to the table (as distinct from those in the body of the text) should appear immediately below the table-width line at the bottom of the table. Separate each table from the adjacent text with one blank line.

### Footnotes

The use of footnotes is discouraged. However, if they are absolutely required, footnotes\*<sup>1</sup> are formatted as normal text paragraphs, single spaced, justified and indented, and are separated from the text above them by a thin (0.75 point) line 2 in. long as shown at the bottom of this page.

\*1 Footnotes must be located entirely within the margins specified above.

## REFERENCES

References must be numbered consecutively. Reference numbers in the text should be typed as superscripts with a closing parenthesis, for example, <sup>1)</sup>, <sup>2,3)</sup> and <sup>4-6)</sup>. List all of the references at the end of the text. Include the names of all the authors with the family names last. Refer to the following examples for the proper format.

### Journals<sup>1)</sup>

Use the standard abbreviations for journal names given in the International Standard ISO 4. Give the volume number, the year of publication and the first page number.

### Conference Proceedings<sup>2)</sup>

Give the title of the proceedings, the editor's name if any, the publisher's name, the place of publication, the year of publication and the page number.

### Books<sup>3,4)</sup>

Give the title, the volume number, the editor's name if any, the publisher's name, the place of publication, the year of publication and the page number.

Please submit your manuscript in PDF format. If you cannot create a PDF file on your own, you can submit your manuscript in MS Word format. The file size should be less than 2 Mbytes Do not use 2-byte characters for Asian languages because they may not appear correctly in the proceedings.

Please submit your manuscript via the Galvatech2015 Abstract Submittal website at: <http://galvatech.aist.org/openconf.php> no later than 1 February 2015 for review and 15 March 2015 the final manuscript using the Abstract ID# issued at time of submittal. Please do not send your manuscript by e-mail.
