Burritt joined U. S. Steel in September 2013 to serve as executive vice president and chief financial officer with responsibility for all aspects of the company's strategic and financial matters. In January 2015, he added executive leadership of U. S. Steel's North American flat rolled commercial entities and corporate support services.

He holds a bachelor's degree in accounting from Bradley University in Peoria, III., USA, and received an M.B.A. from the University of Illinois in Champaign in 1990.
