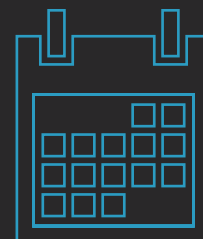

## President's Award Breakfast »

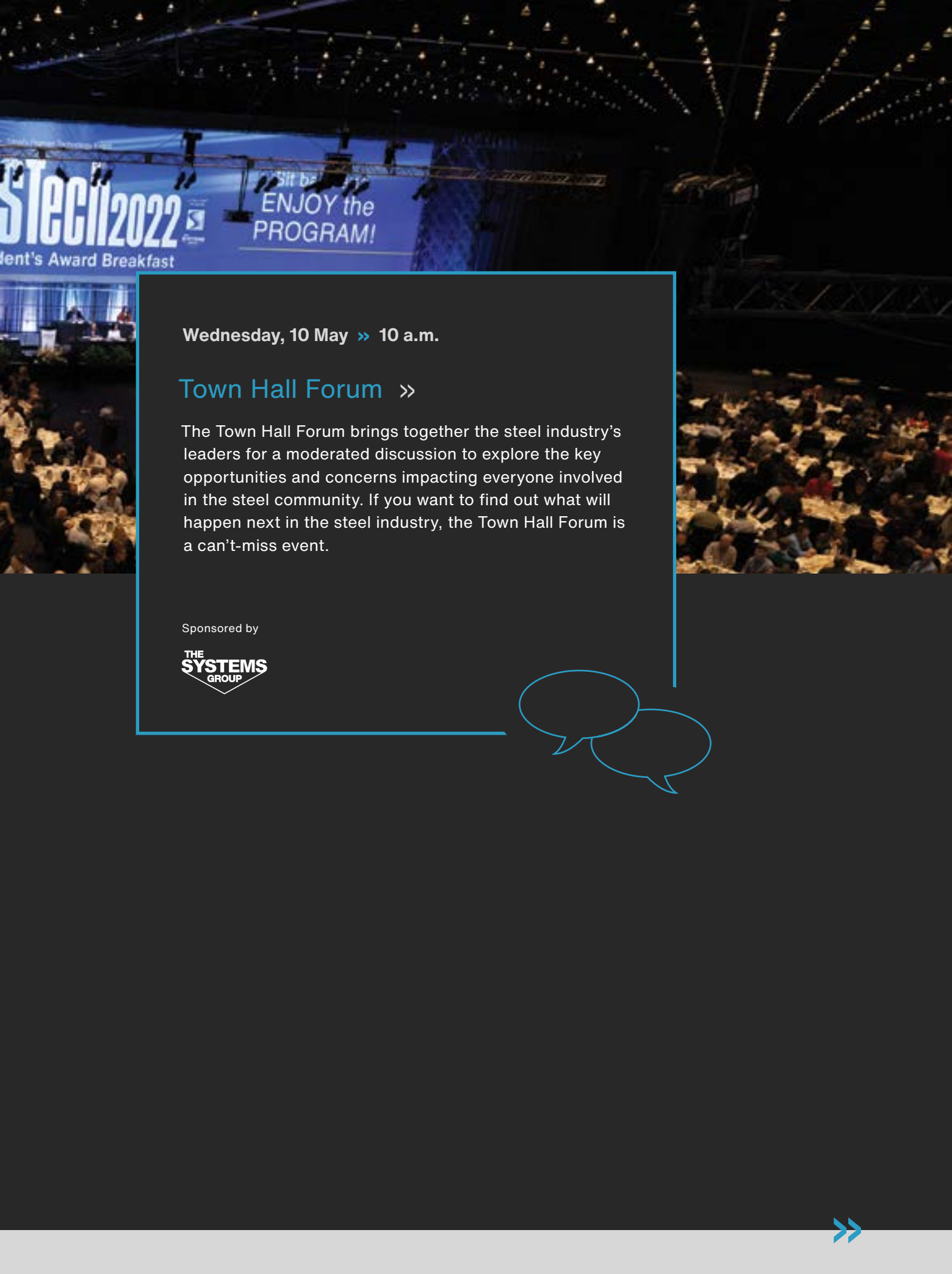
