## U. S. STEEL NAMES INTERIM LEADER OF TUBULAR SEGMENT

S. Steel Serbia in 2006. He went on to become president and general manager of U. S. Steel Canada in 2007, before being named vice president-Tubular Operations and president- U. S. Steel Tubular Products in 2009. He advanced to senior vice president - North American flat rolled operations in 2013, and assumed his current role in 2016.

A native of Uniontown, Pa., Matthews graduated from Pennsylvania State University with a bachelor’s degree in electrical engineering and received a master’s degree in business administration from Duquesne University.

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
