- Academic Transcript Transcripts should show a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.

Applications will be evaluated and scored as follows: Steel Industry Interest – 35%; Recommendation Letters – 30%; Grades – 20%; Extra-Curricular Activities – 15%
